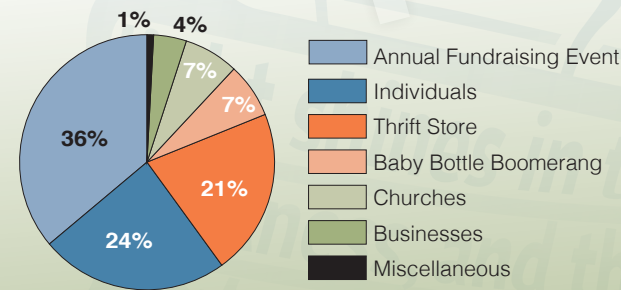
- New location open on ESU campus in the next 12 months
