OUR VISION

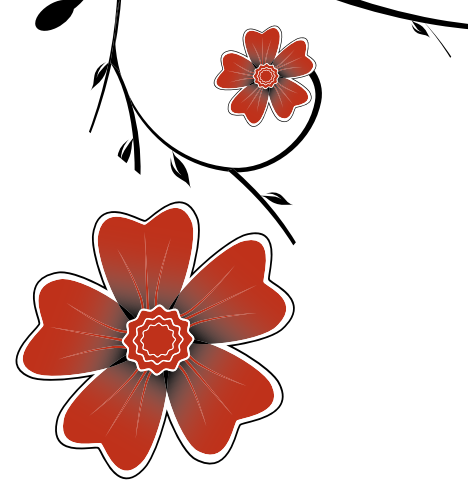
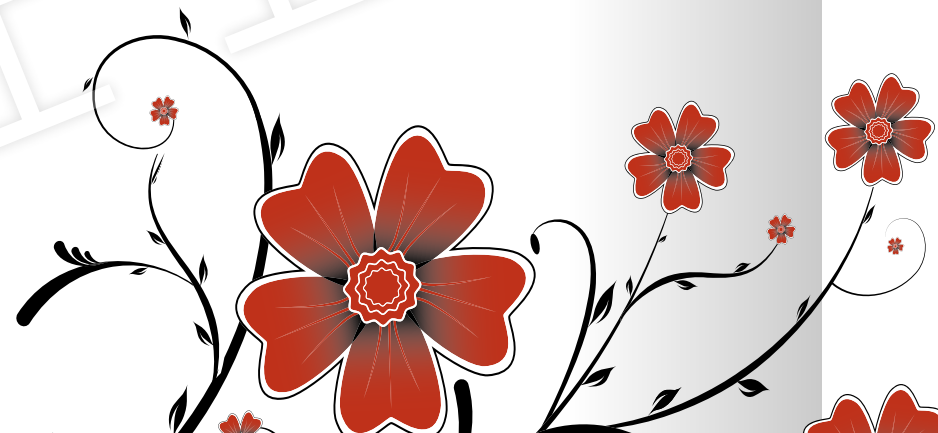

2011 EXPENSES



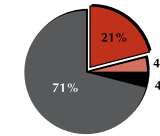

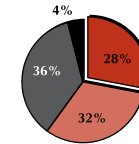

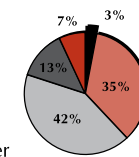

Fundraiser - garage sale, breakfast, or other event, to raise funds for Care Net.

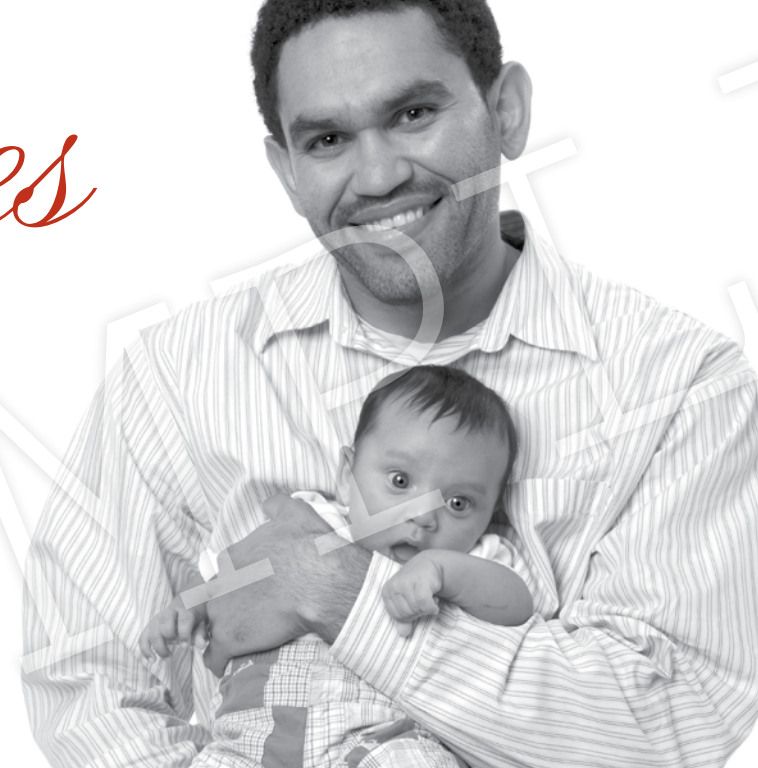
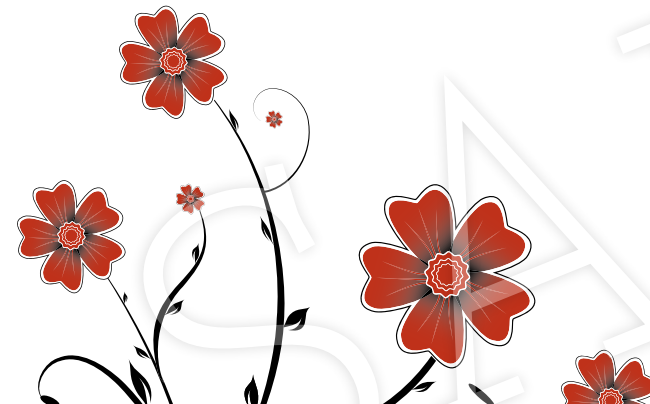
